May 25th a down payment was made on the property and the paperwork began the rounds of the various govt. offices. In a week or so we will hold the deeds in our hands. In the meantime landfill is in progress and as of today 80 loads of earth have been dumped in the area where the houses will be built. Construction can start next week. Three crews of builders will be employed to speed things up and give those kids a decent place to live as soon as possible! It takes about six weeks to build a house.

Our transition house in Phnom Penh is progressing as well. The small house is beautifully renovated and can now serve as a guest house until we have children who need to live there. The first guests are a team of six people from Engineering Ministries International. They are here to help us plan the next stage which will be a multi-storied dorm for our post high school students who will take further training in Phnom Penh. We are so grateful for the help of these kind friends.
