My time in Canada was fantastic! Thanks so much to all of you who listened to me as I told the story of Place of Rescue more than 60 times. Your words of love and support were a huge encouragement to me. Thanks for your financial support and for offering to sponsor our children. Thanks for buying the booksand for reading them. You surprised me over and over again. Thanks for times when we joined our hearts in worship songs to Jesus. You gave me your hearts as I shared mine with you. Now I believe you are praying for us as we desire to continue to prosper and grow.



While I was in Canada we received more children, AIDS families and grannies. We now have 243 children at Place of Rescue I and 86 at Place of Rescue II. They have come out of sad situations and we are so glad they are rescued. One family of five came because their father murdered their mother. This is our second family like this. Others have been beaten, been hungry or had to work picking up recyclable garbage. Please pray for their emotional and spiritual healing as they learn to live in the love of Jesus.

Cambodian New Year's is coming up. If our children have relatives who can receive them we allow them to go visit for a few days. This could be risky as they return to places that were difficult for them in the past. But it is important for them to stay connected with extended family. Please pray that the children will remain faithful to the Lord Jesus no matter where they are and will trust Him to help them. Pray also for the kids who have no-one and will stay here with us.



We still need about 70 sponsors for children from both orphanages. Please pray and consider if you would like to share in the wonderful privilege of providing for the needs of one of our kids. Sponsorship is \$50 a month and this provides for all the food, clothing, medical expenses and education of a child.
