Baby Samuel joined our family on May 23rd. He is a healthy little guy born to a girl abandoned by her boy friend. We now have 23 babies in the baby houses plus 2 babies living with their moms who have AIDS and 2 belonging to staff. Five of our babies have AIDS. All are doing well on anti-retroviral drugs. Baby pb (named after Paul Brandt) came to us weighing 1.8 kilos when he was about 2 weeks old. Now at 6 1/2 months he weighs about 6 kilos. He is doing so well. That's him smiling at you in the hands of his loving care-giver. (The one with the orange shirt) Another 6 month old baby with AIDS will join us soon.

One Granny went to be with Jesus the same day Samuel was born. We now have 22 grannies, one blind woman and one woman who is seriously handicapped.



On May 25 we took Emma Emgard, a member of the board of Place of Rescue, Canada, her brother and niece to visit Place of Rescue II where we now have 96 children. On the way we stopped at a village to pick up Bope who is now happily settled at Place of Rescue I (see the blog about her on our website) Her mother abandoned her when she was very small, her father works on the border of Thailand and comes to see her only once in a long while, her grandmother who was caring for her died recently and Bope was left in the care of her alcoholic uncle. Worst of all, she slept in his bed every night. We are so glad she is rescued!

More than 70 teens call Place of Rescue I home. Most of them are amazing. We had two fantastic prayer meetings this week as they joined to seek the Lord concerning some serious problems. They prayed for each other, especially for one of the girls who had swallowed 15 paracetamol tablets. She is O.K. physically but obviously has emotional and spiritual problems. They prayed for our financial situation. They prayed for some who had to leave. They prayed they might love the Lord and obey the rules here and they prayed about their futures.
